



GREENWAY CORRIDOR

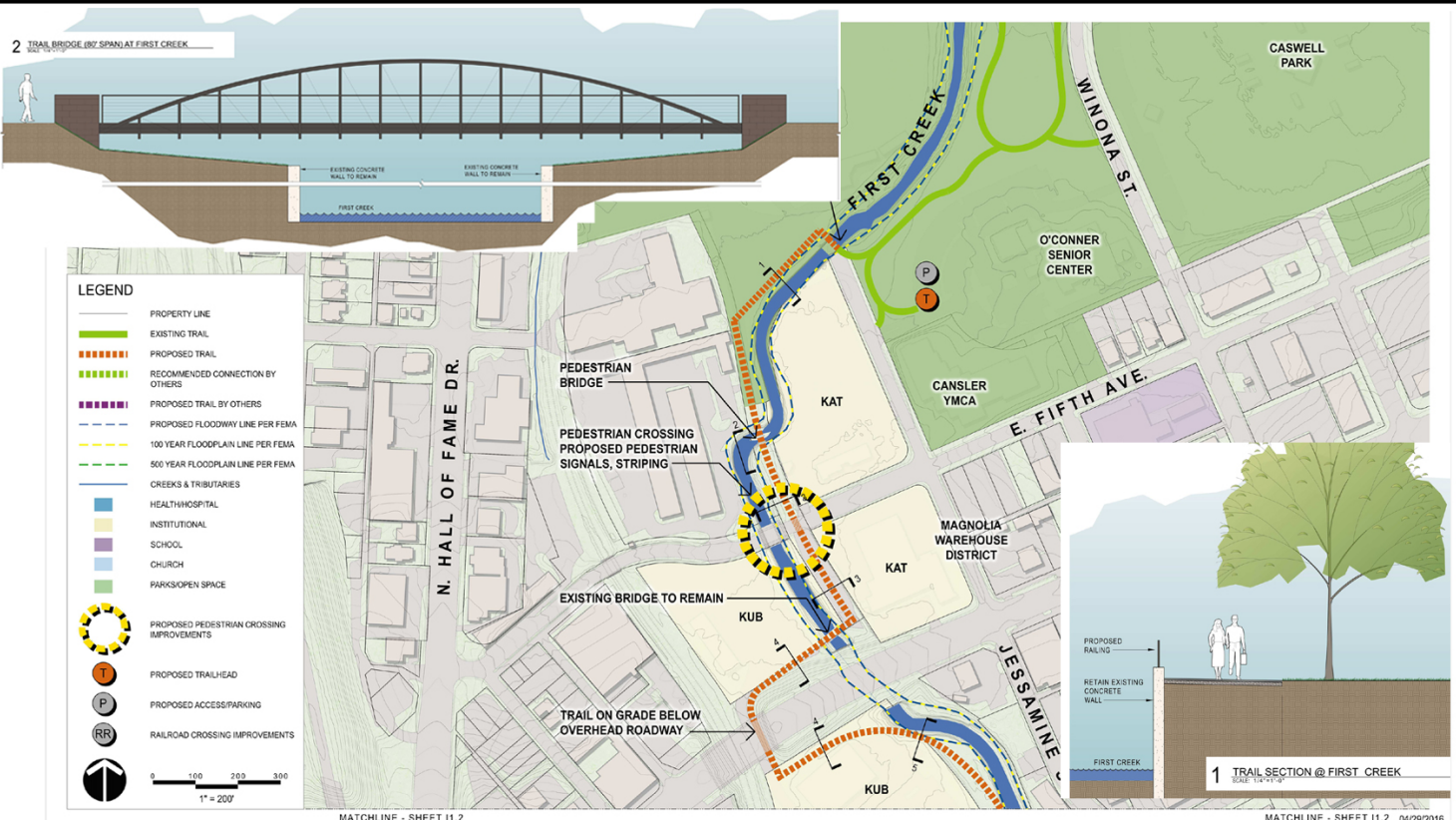
Feasibility & Assessment Project

This project includes the preliminary engineering and assessment of approximately 24 miles of proposed greenway trail. This distance covers 13 proposed greenway corridors to fill in existing gaps between Knoxville's major greenways. After city staff applied for and received an L-STP grant, Ross/Fowler was hired to determine feasible greenway trail routes for connectivity and future greenway development. Factors identified include routing obstacles, connectivity and open space opportunities, right-of-way needs, project costs, timeframes, and grant-funded versus local-funded project implications.
